Student input on their daily behavior-Your child is asked each day how "they" think their day went. The key for this is: Star= I had a good day! Triangle= I made a few mistakes..., Square= I need to make better choices tomorrow... We emphasize that "mistakes are okay" and that everyday is a clean slate.
